Defendant waives the reading of the indictment and was given a copy thereof. Defendant informs the court that his true name is Elmer Julius Johnson. It is ordered all future proceedings against defendant to under the name of Elmer Julius Johnson.
Defendant informs the court that Fryberger, Fulton & Brochus Esq. are his attorneys.
Defendant waives statutory time to plead, and enters a plea that he is not guilty.
Bail fixed in the sum of \$15,000.00
