

Gentlemen:-

Answering your inquiry of June 28th, regarding
pardon for No. 5151 Gilbert Henry Stephenson,
I beg to say that this man was the first one
convicted of Rioting in the riot arising out of
the lynching of three negroes in this city last
June.

Quite a lengthy statement of the facts in con-
nection with the case accompanied his applicat-
ion, and the Pardon Board is no doubt quite fully
conversant with all of the incidents in connection
with the Riot.
